- **Topic #2: Clarification of bylaw rule 8.** Reg Williams wanted a clarification of bylaw rule 8 (the number of players required for a match)

Three separate issues were debated

1. Whether to keep the rule for the coming season  
The vote was carried to keep the rule
2. Do you need 6 registered players available to invoke the rule  
The vote carried that there must be 6 registered players available
3. Can the opposing captain can pick any player who has already played.  
The vote carried that he can pick any player, even those not present at the end of the 6<sup>th</sup> frame.

- **Topic #3: Semi-finals on neutral tables** : Lloyd Baker requested that semi-finals be played at a neutral venue as well as the finals.

John Fenlon, stated that he was happy to do this but would share the semi finals across all venues. Including those that are deemed to be “not good” tables  
the vote carried to play semi finals on neutral tables and share across the venues.
