4. New Teams.

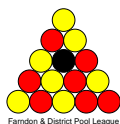
The Cunliffe were voted into the league

6. Treasurers Report.

The balance has increased by £131 since last season. This is due to recycling of unclaimed trophies. It is expected that the cost of trophies will increase this year.

7. Any other Business.

- **Topic #1: Presentation of division 1 merit trophy.**

Aaron Crofts was presented with the Division 1 merit trophy after a play off with Paul Parry.

- **Topic #2: Replacement of perpetual trophies:**

Approximately 5 of the perpetual trophies need to be replaced. The cost will be between £30 and £35 per trophy or up to £75 for a shield, after a discussion it was **decided that Grant would look into it.**

- **Topic #3: Changing the point system:**
